Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to section 4 of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. §717c, and Part 154 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) hereby submits for filing Third Revised Sheet No. 33B to its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1. The proposed effective date of the enclosed tariff sheet is December 31, 2005.

Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis

The purpose of the instant filing is to remove the South Marsh Island Block 130 C point (SMI 130 C) from the list of gathering points included in Transco's FERC Gas Tariff to which a separately stated gathering rate applies. The instant filing originates from the sale of the dehydration facility located at SMI 130 C to Energy Resource Technology, Inc. on December 31, 2005. The SMI 130 C dehydration facility is classified as gathering for rate and accounting purposes and constitutes the basis for Transco's imposition of a gathering rate applicable to volumes traversing the South Marsh Island Block 130 C point. No gas has flowed through the facility since April 2004. Transco will cease assessment of the gathering rate to volumes transported from this location.

Proposed Effective Date

Transco respectfully requests that the Commission grant a waiver of Section 154.207 of its regulations in order that the enclosed tariff sheet be made effective December 31, 2005. Transco submits that good cause exists to grant the requested waiver as it will cease assessing the gathering

charge on the date of sale of the dehydration facility, which date is December 31, 2005. In the event that the Commission elects to accept and suspend the revised tariff sheet submitted herein, in accordance with Section 154.7(a)(9) of the Commission's Regulations (Regulations), Transco moves to place such tariff sheet into effect at the end of the applicable suspension period.

Take notice that on January 4, 2006, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) tendered for filing as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1, Third Revised Sheet No. 33B, to become effective December 31, 2005.

Transco states that the purpose of the instant filing is to remove South Marsh Island Block 130 C from the list of gathering points included in its currently effective tariff.

Anyone filing an intervention or protest on or before the intervention or protest date need not serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.
