Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to section 4 of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. §717c, and Part 154 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) hereby submits for filing, Thirty-Seventh Revised Sheet No. 28 to its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1. The proposed effective date of the attached tariff sheet is August 1, 2007.

Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis

The purpose of the instant filing is to track rate changes attributable to storage service purchased from Texas Eastern Transmission, LP under its Rate Schedule X-28 the costs of which are included in the rates and charges payable under Transco's Rate Schedule S-2. This filing is being made pursuant to tracking provisions under Section 26 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's Third Revised Volume No. 1 Tariff.

Proposed Effective Date

The tariff sheet submitted herein is proposed to be effective August 1, 2007. Transco respectfully requests that the Commission grant a waiver of Section 154.207 of its Regulations in order that the enclosed tariff sheet be made effective as proposed herein.

In the event the Commission elects to accept and suspend the revised tariff sheet submitted herein, in accordance with Section 154.7(a)(9) of the Commission's Regulations (Regulations), Transco moves to place such tariff sheet into effect at the end of the applicable suspension period.

Notice of Proposed Changes in FERC Gas Tariff
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Take notice that on July 25, 2007, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) tendered for filing as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1, Thirty-Seventh Revised Sheet No. 28, to become effective August 1, 2007.

Transco states that the purpose of the instant filing is to track rate changes attributable to storage service purchased from Texas Eastern Transmission, LP under its Rate Schedule X-28, the costs of which are included in the rates and charges payable under Transco's Rate Schedule S-2. This filing is being made pursuant to tracking provisions under Section 26 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's Third Revised Volume No. 1 Tariff.

Any person wishing to become a party must file a notice of intervention or motion to intervene, as appropriate. Such notices, motions, or protests must be filed in accordance with the provisions of Section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations (18 CFR 154.210). Anyone filing an intervention or protest must serve a copy of that document on the Applicant. Anyone filing an intervention or protest on or before the intervention or protest date need not serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.

Appendix A

Rate Schedule S-2 effective August 1, 2007

On June 29, 2007, Texas Eastern Transmission, LP (Texas Eastern) filed revised tariff sheets in Docket No. RP07-502-000 to reflect an increase in its Electric Power Cost Adjustment. Included in the filing are revised rates under Texas Eastern's Rate Schedule X-28 which Transco uses to render service to its customers under its Rate Schedule S-2. The Commission issued a Letter Order on July 19, 2007 accepting the revised tariff sheets in Docket No. RP07-502-000, effective August 1, 2007.
