Take notice that on July 31, 2007 Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) filed a report reflecting the flow through of refunds received from Dominion Transmission, Inc.

On July 31, 2007 in accordance with section 4 of its Rate Schedule LSS, section 4 of its Rate Schedule FT-NT and section 3 of its Rate Schedule GSS, Transco states that it refunded to its LSS, FT-NT and GSS customers 23,316.14 resulting from the refund of Dominion Transmission, Inc.

Anyone filing an intervention or protest on or before the intervention or protest date need not serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.
