Dear Ms. Salas:



Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to section 4 of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. §717c, and Part 154 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) hereby submits for filing, Thirtieth Revised Sheet No. 28 to its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1. The proposed effective date of the attached tariff sheet is August 1, 2005.

**Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis**

The purpose of the instant filing is to track rate changes attributable to storage service purchased from Texas Eastern Transmission, LP (Texas Eastern) under its Rate Schedule X-28 the costs of which are included in the rates and charges payable under Transco's Rate Schedule S-2. This filing is being made pursuant to tracking provisions under Section 26 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's Third Revised Volume No. 1 Tariff.

**Materials Submitted Herewith**

In accordance with Section 154.7(a)(1) of the Commission's Regulations (Regulations), the following material is submitted herewith:

- (1) In accordance with Section 154.209 of the Regulations, a proposed form of notice for the instant filing suitable for publication in the Federal Register, and a diskette copy of such notice labeled NT081005.ASC;
- (2) the revised tariff sheet, a redlined version of the tariff sheet submitted in the instant filing in accordance with the provision under Section 154.201(a) of the Regulations, and as required by Section 154.4 of the Regulations, a diskette copy of such sheet labeled TF081005.ASC;
- (3) Appendix A which contains the explanation of the rate changes and details regarding the computation of the revised S-2 rates.

**Proposed Effective Date**

Transco respectfully requests that the Commission grant a waiver of Section 154.207 of its regulations in order that the enclosed tariff sheet be made effective August 1, 2005. In the event the Commission elects to accept and suspend the revised tariff sheet submitted herein, in accordance with Section 154.7(a)(9) of the Commission's Regulations, Transco moves to place such tariff sheet into effect at the end of the applicable suspension period.


