Take notice that on August 15, 2006 Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation (Transco) filed a report reflecting the flow through of refunds received from Texas Gas Transmission, LLC (Texas Gas) in Docket No. RP05-317 et al. On August 15, 2006 Transco, in accordance with Section 4 of its Rate Schedule FT-NT, flowed through the amount of \$169,074.46 refunded by Texas Gas to its FT-NT customer.

Anyone filing an intervention or protest must serve a copy of that document on the Applicant. Anyone filing an intervention or protest on or before the intervention or protest date need not serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.
