Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Rule 2008 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), 18 C.F.R. § 385.2008, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation ("Transco") hereby submits for filing with the Commission a request for further extension of time to fully comply with NAESB Version 1.7 Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60.

Background

On July 1, 2005, Transco submitted its filing to comply with Order No. 587-S¹ ("Compliance Filing"). In that Compliance Filing, Transco requested an extension of time until October 1, 2005, to implement certain tariff sheets, including those tariff sheets necessary to comply with NAESB WGQ Version 1.7 Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60. In a letter order dated August 11, 2005², the Commission approved Transco's Compliance Filing and granted Transco's request for an extension of time to comply with NAESB WGQ Version 1.7 Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60. Specifically, the Commission accepted the following tariff sheets to be effective October 1, 2005:


These tariff sheets revise Section 18 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's FERC Gas Tariff ("GT&C"), "Determination of Deliveries and Receipts, Allowable Daily Dispatching Variations, Overrun Charges and Penalties", to comply with NAESB WGQ Version 1.7 Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60.

On September 9, 2005, Transco submitted, in Docket No. RP05-480-001, Substitute Original Sheet No. 276D to correct a wording error in subsection 18.1(c)(ii)(A)(3) of the GT&C. In a letter order dated September 28, 2005, the Commission accepted Substitute Original Sheet No. 276D effective October 1, 2005.

Request for Extension of Time

Due to delays in the development and implementation of programming changes to Transco's ILine business system caused by hurricanes Rita and Katrina, Transco will not be able to implement the ILine programming changes necessary to comply with NAESB WGQ Version 1.7 Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60 by October 1, 2005. Due to the impact of these hurricanes, personnel have been redirected to support the existing ILine system, and in-house testing and customer training have been postponed. Therefore, Transco respectfully seeks an extension of time, until November 1, 2005, to make the modifications to ILine necessary to comply with NAESB WGQ Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60. Transco submits that good cause exists for the grant by the Commission of the relief requested herein. As discussed above, the delay in implementing the ILine programming changes necessary to comply with these standards is the result of unforeseen and unexpected circumstances. Transco continues to allocate substantial resources, including time, personnel and funding to complete the programming changes as expediently as possible. Accordingly, Transco requests an extension of time, until November 1, 2005, to comply with NAESB WGQ Version 1.7 Standards 2.3.59 and 2.3.60 as reflected on the tariff sheets identified above.
