Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line ("Transco") hereby submits for filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") Substitute Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30 to its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1 ("Tariff") to correct an error contained on Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30, which Transco submitted to the Commission on September 29, 2006 in Docket No. RP06-619.

**Statement of Nature, Reasons, and Basis for Filing**

On September 29, 2006, in Docket No. RP06-619, Transco filed for approval by the Commission an amendment to a Non-Conforming Part 284 Service Agreement and submitted Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30 and Second Revised Sheet No. 30A to update its Tariff listing of Non-Conforming Service Agreements ("September 29 Filing"). Transco has subsequently discovered that Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30, submitted in the September 29 Filing, incorrectly states, as October 1, 2006, the effective date of the amendment to the Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia service agreement. The correct effective date of such amendment is November 1, 2006.

Transco submits herein Substitute Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30 as a replacement for Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30 contained in the September 29 Filing. Substitute Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30 reflects the correct amendment date of November 1, 2006.

**Proposed Effective Date**

Transco respectfully requests that the Commission grant any and all waivers of its regulations that it deems necessary to accept Substitute Ninth Revised Sheet No. 30 submitted herein effective November 1, 2006, the same effective date Transco requests in the September 29 filing. In the event the Commission elects to accept and suspend the revised tariff sheet, in accordance with Section 154.7(a)(9) of the Commission's regulation, Transco moves to place such tariff sheet into effect at the end of the applicable suspension period.

Anyone filing an intervention or protest on or before the intervention or protest date need not serve motions to intervene or protests on persons other than the Applicant.
