Ladies and Gentlemen:

Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation ("Transco") submits herewith for filing the additional information requested in the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") November 14, 2005 Letter Order in the referenced docket ("November 14 Letter Order").

Statement of Nature, Reasons and Basis

On October 25, 2005, Transco filed with the Commission a non-conforming service agreement under Rate Schedule FT between Transco and South Jersey Gas Company and tariff sheets to reflect such agreement in its tariff. In the November 14 Letter Order, the Commission accepted the service agreement and the tariff sheets "effective the later of November 1, 2005, or the date Transco's Central New Jersey Expansion Project facilities are ready for service." The Commission then required Transco to notify the Commission of the actual effective date of the tariff sheets.

Attached, in response to the Commission's directive, is a copy of Transco's "Notification of Placement into Service" dated November 7, 2005 which notified the Commission that the facilities authorized in the Central New Jersey Expansion Project were placed in service on November 1, 2005. Therefore, the effective date of the tariff sheets submitted in this proceeding (Twenty-First Revised Sheet No. 1, Sixth Revised Sheet No. 30, and First Revised Sheet No. 31) is November 1, 2005.


