RP15-295-000 – Transco has filed a tariff record that summarizes the essential elements of service agreements that contain negotiated commodity rates under Rate Schedule FT. The tariff record is proposed to be effective January 1, 2015.

RP15-239-000 – Transco LLC filed revised tariff sheets in Docket No. RP15-239-000 in order to track revised rate and fuel percentage changes attributable to storage services purchased from Texas Eastern Transmission, LP. The effective date of Transco’s revised Rate Schedule S-2 rates and fuel percentages is December 1, 2014.

##### [11-25-14 – Negotiated Rates – Cherokee/AGL](#)

RP15-205-000 – Transco has filed a tariff record that summarizes the essential elements of service agreements that contain negotiated commodity rates under Rate Schedule FT. The tariff record and negotiated rates are proposed to be effective December 1, 2014.

##### [11-25-14 – Negotiated Rate – Northeast Connector Project](#)

RP15-204-000 – Transco has filed a tariff record summarizing the essential elements of a service agreement under Rate Schedule FT that contains a negotiated rate between Transco and the Brooklyn Union Gas Company, d/b/a National Grid NY. The tariff record is proposed to be effective on December 1, 2014, the anticipated date that partial service commences under Transco's Northeast Connector Project.

##### [11-19-14 – IDLS Revenue Sharing Report](#)

RP15-185-000 – Transco submitted revenue sharing refunds to affected shippers on the Delta Lateral under Rate Schedules FDLS and IDLS pursuant to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s October 28, 2009 “Order Issuing Certificate” in Docket No. CP09-237-000. The amounts refunded were collected for each annual period ending September 30, 2012, 2013 and 2014.

##### [11-12-14 – Compliance Filing – Order to Show Cause](#)

RP14-963-001 – Transco has submitted a filing in compliance with a Commission "Order on Filings in Compliance with Order to Show Cause" issued on October 16, 2014 requiring Transco to file revised tariff language to clarify that a party's offer to purchase released capacity will be maintained on

Transco's 1Line website for whatever period the party desires, subject to a cap of no less than 30 days. The revised tariff record is proposed to be effective October 16, 2014.

#### [11-05-14 – Revised GT&C Section 39 – Shipper Consent Timeline](#)

RP15-148-000 – Transco has submitted a filing to revise Section 39 of the General Terms and Conditions of its tariff to revise the procedure for processing requests for adjustments to prior gas day scheduled quantities and predetermined allocations. The proposed revision removes a time limitation for customers to communicate their consent to such requests for adjustments. The revised tariff record is proposed to be effective December 6, 2014.

RP15-95-000 – Transco filed revised tariff sheets to track third party rate changes attributable to storage services purchased from Dominion Transmission, Inc. The effective date of the revised LSS and GSS rates is November 1, 2014.

#### [10-30-14 – Northeast Connector Project Initial Rates](#)

RP15-88-000 – Transco filed rates for its Northeast Connector Project. The effective date of the rates are December 1, 2014, the projected in-service for partial service of the project.

#### [10-30-14 – Negotiated Rates – Cherokee/AGL](#)

RP15-85-000 – Transco has filed a tariff record that summarizes the essential elements of service agreements that contain negotiated commodity rates under Rate Schedule FT. The tariff record and negotiated rates are proposed to be effective November 1, 2014.

#### [10-22-14 – Penalty Sharing Report](#)

RP15-60-000 – Transco submitted for filing in Docket No. RP15-60-000 a Revenue Sharing of Penalty Dollars for the three year period ending July 31, 2014. The amount of penalty and interest shared was \$1,159,784.26.

#### [10-21-14 – Virginia Southside Initial Rates](#)

RP15-56-000 – Transco filed rates for its Virginia Southside Expansion. The effective date of the rates are December 1, 2014, the projected in-service for partial service of the project.

#### [10-01-14 – GT&C Section 19 – DPE Provisions](#)

RP15-18-000 – Transco has filed proposed revisions to Sections 19.1 and 19.2, Maximum Daily Delivery Point Entitlements (“DPEs”) and Maximum Daily Delivery Entitlement By Facility Group, respectively, of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco’s tariff. The purpose of the filing is to align the DPE provisions more closely with the current tariff and business and operational practices. The revised tariff records are proposed to be effective November 1, 2014.

RP14-1285-000 – Transco has filed a tariff record that summarizes the essential elements of service agreements that contain negotiated commodity rates under Rate Schedule FT. The tariff record and negotiated rates are proposed to be effective October 1, 2014.

RP14-1253-000 – Transco submitted a filing on September 8, 2014 to make miscellaneous revisions to Transco's Tariff to clean up certain references, reflect name changes, update the list of gathering locations and correct certain grammatical errors. RP14-1139-000 – Transco has submitted a filing to notify the Commission of the cancellation of Rate Schedule X-269 and to update Transco's tariff by removing references to Rate Schedule X-269 to reflect its conversion from Part 157 service to Part 284 open-access service under Rate Schedule FT. The revised tariff records are proposed to be effective August 1, 2014.

The revised tariff records are proposed to be effective July 1, 2014.

RP14-833-000 – Transco submitted a filing to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in Docket No. RP14-833-000 to revise certain storage and transportation rates in accordance with Article I, Section A.5(b) of the August 27, 2013 Stipulation and Agreement filed in Docket Nos. RP12-993-000, et al. The proposed effective date of the filing is June 1, 2014.

RP14-792-000 – Transco has filed tariff records that summarize the essential elements of service agreements that contain negotiated commodity rates under Rate Schedule FT. The tariff records and negotiated rates are proposed to be effective May 1, 2014.

#### [04-22-14 – SS-2 Annual Gas Balance Adjustment Filing](#)

RP14-763-000 – Transco filed tariff records reflecting the annual adjustment made by National Fuel to Transco's storage inventory under National Fuel's Rate Schedule SS-1 related to transportation purchased by Transco under National Fuel's Rate Schedule X-54. RP14-46-001 - Transco has filed a motion to place into effect certain suspended tariff records that clarify in Transco's Rate Schedules FT, FT-G, FTN, and FDLS the primary rights of firm shippers at receipt points. The revised tariff records are effective April 16, 2014.

#### [03-31-14 – Cancellation of Negotiated Rates – Staten Island](#)

RP14-701-000 – Transco has submitted for filing tariff records to reflect the removal from Transco's Volume No. 1A tariff of two amendments that set forth a negotiated facilities surcharge in two service agreements under Rate Schedule FT. The surcharge has been recalculated, and the two amendments are being replaced by superseding amendments. The tariff records are proposed to be effective April 1, 2014.

RP14-625-000 – Transco submitted a filing in Docket No. RP14-625-000 to eliminate Rate Schedules X-274 and X-275 from Transco's First Revised Volume No. 2 Tariff. This filing supplements a filing made by Transco on February 27, 2014 in Docket No. RP14-528-000 which removed references to Rate Schedules X-274 and X-275 from Transco's Fifth Revised Volume No. 1 Tariff. These rate schedules had been converted from Section 7(c) firm transportation service to Part 284 transportation service under Rate Schedule FT. The proposed effective date of the revised tariff records is November 1, 2013.

RP14-615-000 – Transco has filed to remove two negotiated rate FT service agreements which are no longer non-conforming from Transco's Volume No. 1A tariff. The revised tariff records are proposed to be effective April 1, 2014.

#### [03-06-14 – GSS and LSS Tracker Filing](#)

RP14-606-000 – Transco filed tariff records to track fuel retention percentage changes attributable to storage services purchased from Dominion Transmission Inc. under its Rate Schedule GSS, the costs of which are included in Transco's Rate Schedules GSS and LSS. The proposed effective dates of the tariff records are March 1, 2014 and April 1, 2014.

RP14-565-000 – Transco filed tariff records proposed effective April 1, 2014 to revise the Trenton Woodbury Expansion surcharge tariff record to reflect the fact that this surcharge will no longer apply to Virginia Power Energy Marketing, Inc. contracts, and to establish a new recourse reservation rate (identical to the reservation surcharge rate) under Rate Schedule FT for Trenton Woodbury Expansion service to Virginia Power Energy Marketing, Inc.

RP14-537-000 – Transco has filed a tariff record that summarizes the essential elements of service agreements that contain negotiated commodity rates under Rate Schedule FT. The tariff record and negotiated rates are proposed to be effective March 1, 2014.

#### [02-27-14 – Cancellation of Rate Schedules X-274 and X-275](#)

RP14-528-000 – Transco filed Docket No. RP14-528-000 notifying the Commission of the cancellation of Rate Schedules X-274 and X-275 from its FERC Gas Tariff, Volume No. 2. The filing also updated Transco's FERC Gas Tariff, Fifth Revised Volume No. 1 by removing references to Rate Schedules X-274 and X-275. The tariff records are to be made effective April 1, 2014.

#### [02-27-14 – Electric Power Filing](#)

RP14-526-000 – Transco filed revised Electric Power rates pursuant to Section 41 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's FERC Gas Tariff. The proposed effective date of the tariff records is April 1, 2014.

#### [02-24-14 – Annual Fuel Tracker Filing](#)

RP14-507-000 – Transco filed its annual fuel tracker filing. The tariff records are proposed to be effective April 1, 2014.

#### [02-07-14 – Supplement to Settlement Tariff Records Filing](#)

RP12-993-005 – Transco submitted a tariff record to supplement the January 29, 2014 filing in Docket No. RP12-993-004, which filing was made to electronically submit tariff records containing Commission approved settlement rates in Transco's general NGA section 4 rate proceeding. The supplemental Rate Schedule S-2 tariff record was filed in Docket No. RP12-993-005 to incorporate therein a Commission approved rate change filed by Texas Eastern Transmission, LP, effective February 1, 2014.

RP14-419-000 – Transco filed rate changes resulting from a change in the 3rd party rates underlying Rate Schedule S-2. The filing was made in Docket No. RP14-419-000. The proposed effective date of the tariff section is February 1, 2014.

RP12-993-004 – Transco submitted a filing to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. RP12-993-004 to place tariff records into effect consistent with Appendices D and E to the Stipulation and Agreement filed on August 27, 2013 ("Agreement"). The Commission approved the Agreement on December 6, 2013 ("December 6 Order"). The Pro Forma tariff records in Appendix E to the Agreement, which have been updated to reflect authorized limited NGA Section 4 rate filings made since the Agreement was filed, have an effective date of March 1, 2014, consistent with the December 6 Order.
