## Transco's General Section 4 Rate Case Filing (Docket No. RP18-1126)

Transco has been served with, and has responded to, numerous discovery requests by several participants, including the Commission's Staff. The discovery process is continuing. On February 28, 2019, Transco filed motions to make effective March 1, 2019 rates that were adjusted to remove the cost of facilities not in service as of February 28, 2019. Transco began billing the motion rates effective March 1, 2019, subject to refund.

## Transco's Annual Electric Power Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP19-800-000)

On March 1, 2019, Transco made its annual electric power tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2019. The revised rates can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

## Transco's Annual Fuel Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP19-798-000)

On March 1, 2019, Transco made its annual fuel tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2019. The revised fuel retention percentages can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

## Environmental Assessment Issued for Southeastern Trail Expansion Project (Docket No. CP18-186)

On February 8, 2019, the Commission issued an environmental assessment ("EA") for the Southeastern Trail Expansion Project. The EA assesses the potential environmental effects of the construction and operation of the project in accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act. The Commission staff concluded that approval of the project, with appropriate mitigation measures, will not constitute a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment. Comments on the EA are due on, or before, March 11, 2019.
