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General Rate Case Update (Docket No. RP18-1126)

On August 31, 2018, Transco filed a general rate case with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) for an overall increase in rates and to comply with the terms of the settlement in the prior rate case to file a rate case no later than August 31, 2018. On September 28, 2018, the Commission issued an order accepting and suspending our general rate filing to be effective March 1, 2019, subject to refund and the outcome of a hearing, except that rates for certain services that were proposed as overall rate decreases were accepted, without suspension, to be effective October 1, 2018. The decreased rates will not be subject to refund but may be subject to decrease prospectively under Section 5 of the Natural Gas Act of 1938, as amended. On March 18, 2019, the Commission accepted Transco’s motion to place the rates that were suspended by the September 28, 2018 order into effect on March 1, 2019, subject to refund. Transco and the rate case participants have held seven formal settlement conferences. At the conclusion of the October 10, 2019, settlement conference, the participants reported that they had reached a settlement in principle. Dates were established through mutual agreement for documenting the settlement and filing it with the Commission.

Southeastern Trail Project Certificate Issued – (Docket No. CP18-186-000)

On October 17, 2019, the Commission issued a certificate authorizing Transco to construct and operate the Southeastern Trail Project (“Project”). The Project will enable Transco to provide an additional 296,375 dekatherms per day of firm, year-round, transportation service from Transco’s existing Zone 5 Pleasant Valley Interconnect facility between Transco and Dominion Energy Cove Point in Fairfax County, Virginia to the existing Zone 3 Station 65 pooling point located in St. Helena Parish, Louisiana. The target in-service date for the project is November 1, 2020. Transco accepted the certificate on October 23, 2019.

Storage Reservation Credits Filing Accepted (Docket No. RP19-1547-000)

On October 2, 2019, the Commission issued a letter order that accepted the tariff records filed by Transco on September 6, 2019 to add provisions for reservation charge credits when Transco orders the interruption or reduction of firm contract storage service under Rate Schedule WSS-OA, LSS, or SS-2. The tariff records are effective November 1, 2019.

Filing to Revise Forms of Service Agreement (RP19-1599-000)

On October 17, 2019, the Commission approved Transco’s filing to revise the Forms of Service Agreement in Transco’s tariff to include a space to insert an email address for the transmittal of notices to Transco under the service agreements. The revised Forms of Service Agreement are effective November 1, 2019.

Rate Schedule LNG Fuel Tracker Filing (RP20-1-000)

On October 1, 2019, Transco submitted revised tariff records in order to file a determination of its fuel retention percentage applicable to Rate Schedules LG-A, LNG and LG-S. On October 24, 2019, the Commission approved the revised tariff records to be effective November 1, 2019.

Penalty Revenue Sharing Report (Docket No. RP20-88-000)

On October 24, 2019, Transco filed a report of the penalty amount collected during the annual period ending July 31, 2019 that was distributed to shippers pursuant to Section 54 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's tariff. The amount distributed totaled \$71,426.59.

Rate Schedule LNG Modification Filing (Docket No. RP19-1639-000)

On September 30, 2019, Transco submitted a tariff filing to increase the flexibility of service under Rate Schedule LNG (Liquefied Natural Gas Storage Service). On October 29, 2019, the Commission approved the revised tariff records to be effective November 1, 2019.

Rate Schedule GSS & LSS Tracker Filing (RP20-145-000)

On October 31, 2019, Transco filed revised tariff records in order to track third party rate changes attributable to storage services purchased from Dominion Transmission, Inc. The effective date of the revised LSS and GSS rates is November 1, 2019.

Rate Schedule LSS & SS-2 Tracker Filing (RP20-137-000)

On October 31, 2019, Transco filed revised tariff records in order to track third party rate changes attributable to storage services purchased from National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation Transmission, Inc. The effective date of the revised LSS and SS-2 rates is November 1, 2019.

Gateway Expansion Project Initial Rates (RP20-163-000)

On October 31, 2019, Transco filed tariff records with the Commission to establish the initial rates for its Gateway Expansion Project. The tariff records are proposed to be effective December 1, 2019.
