General Rate Case Update (Docket No. RP18-1126)

On August 31, 2018, Transco filed a general rate case with the FERC for an overall increase in rates and to comply with the terms of the settlement in its prior rate case to file a rate case no later than August 31, 2018. In October 2019, Transco reached an agreement on the terms of a settlement with the participants without the need for a hearing. On December 31, 2019, Transco filed a comprehensive Stipulation and Agreement ("Agreement") with the Commission that resolves all issues of Transco's rate case. Comments on the Agreement were due January 21, 2020, and all were in support of the Agreement. Transco anticipates that the Commission will approve the uncontested Agreement to be effective in the second quarter of 2020.

Ordering Approving Rate Schedule S-2 Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP20-440)

On January 17, 2020, Transco filed a revised tariff record in order to track rate changes attributable to storage services purchased from Texas Eastern Transmission, LP under its Rate Schedule X-28 which are included in the rates and charges payable under Transco's Rate Schedule S-2. The effective date of the tariff record is February 1, 2020. The Commission issued an order approving the revised tariff record on February 4, 2020.

Order Granting Abandonment Authority of Rate Schedule X-234 (Docket No. CP19-496)

On January 24, 2020, the Commission issued an order granting the abandonment of the individually certificated natural gas exchange service between the parties provided under Rate Schedule X-234. The abandonment is effective March 31, 2020.

Priority of Service Clarification and Cleanup Filing (Docket No. RP20-455)

On January 29, 2020, Transco submitted a filing to revise certain tariff records that require updates or clarification following the implementation of Transco's Priority of Service Compliance Filing in Docket No. RP19-1225. The revised tariff records are proposed to become effective on February 29, 2020. On February 7, 2020, Transco filed a correction to reject an erroneously included tariff record.

Northeast Supply Enhancement Project Certificate Amendment (Docket No. CP20-49)

On January 31, 2020, Transco filed an amendment to its Northeast Supply Enhancement Project certificate granted in Docket No. CP17-101 seeking authorization to utilize and extend an existing road to access Compressor Station 206 in Somerset County, New Jersey in lieu of constructing a new, certificated access road previously authorized in its certificate.
