<u>Commission Approval of the Stipulation and Agreement Filied in Transco's General</u> <u>Section 4 Rate Case Proceeding (Docket No. RP18-1126)</u>

On March 24, 2020 the Commission issued an order approving the December 31, 2019 Stipulation and Agreement without modification. Absent any requests for rehearing (none are expected), the Stipulation and Agreement will become effective June 1, 2020. Refunds of amounts collected in excess of the settlement rates for the period March 1, 2019 – May 31, 2020, including interest, will be made no later than July 30, 2020.

Approval of Transco's Rate Schedules LSS & SS-2 Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP20-543)

On March 10, 2020, the Commission approved Transco's February 24, 2020 filing to track rate changes attributable to storage services purchased from National Fuel Supply Corporations under its Rate Schedules SS-1 and X-54, which are included in the rates and charges payable under Transco's Rate Schedules LSS and SS-2. The effective date of Transco's revised LSS and SS-2 rates is February 1, 2020.

Approval of Transco's Annual Fuel Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP20-572)

On March 12, 2020, the Commission approved the fuel percentages included in Transco's annual fuel tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2020. The revised fuel retention percentages can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

Approval of Transco's Annual Electric Power Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP20-575)

On March 12, 2020, the Commission approved the rates included in Transco's annual electric power tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2020. The revised rates can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

Rate Schedules LSS & SS-2 Third Party Fuel Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP20-677)

On March 24, 2020, Transco filed revised tariff records in order to track third party fuel retention percentages attributable to storage services purchased from National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation under its Rate Schedule SS-1, which are included in the fuel retention percentages under Transco's Rate Schedules LSS and SS-1. The effective date of the revised LSS and SS-2 fuel percentages is April 1, 2020.

Cash-Out Price Changes (Docket No. RP20-614)

On February 28, 2020, Transco filed revised tariff records with the Commission to change the calculations establishing the prices used for cashing out monthly imbalances remaining at the time of final resolution pursuant to Section 25 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transco's Tariff. On March 30, 2020, the Commission accepted and suspended Transco's proposed tariff records to be effective September 1, 2020, subject to refund, and established hearing procedures. A presiding judge, to be designated by the Chief Judge for that purpose, shall, within 15 days of the date of the presiding judge's designation, convene a prehearing conference for the purpose of establishing a procedural schedule.

Disposition of Cash-Out Costs and Revenues (Docket No. RP20-618)

On February 28, 2020, Transco filed revised tariff records with the Commission to change the procedures used to address over- or under-recoveries resulting from the difference between revenues received and costs incurred by Transco under the cash-out provisions of Transco's Tariff. Specifically, Transco proposes to establish a refund or surcharge rate designed to return to or recover from customers any over- or under-recovery of costs incurred under the cash-out provisions of the Tariff during an annual period. On March 30, 2020, the Commission accepted and suspended Transco's proposed tariff records to be effective September 1, 2020, subject to refund, and established hearing procedures. A presiding judge, to be designated by the Chief Judge for that purpose, shall, within 15 days of the date of the presiding judge's designation, convene a prehearing conference for the purpose of establishing a procedural schedule.
