Motion Filing to Place Suspended Tariff Records into Effect – Order Accepting Filing - RP24-1035-003)

On March 20, 2025, FERC accepted Transco’s February 28, 2025 filing to place into effect the rates suspended in the September 30, 2024 Suspension Order. The tariff records in Appendix A are accepted as requested, and the tariff records in Appendix B are rejected as moot.

Annual Electric Power Tracker – Order Accepting Filing - RP25-667-000

On March 25, 2025, FERC issued a letter order accepting the rate changes in Transco’s February 28, 2025 Annual Electric Power Tracker Filing.

Annual Fuel Tracker – Order Accepting Filing - RP25-660-000

On March 26, 2025, FERC issued a letter order accepting the rate changes in Transco’s February 28, 2025 Annual Fuel Tracker Filing.

Rate Schedule GSS & LSS Fuel Tracker Filing – RP25-746-000

On March 26, 2025, Transco submitted a filing to track the fuel retention percentage attributable to storage service purchased from Eastern Gas Transmission and Storage, Inc, under its Rate Schedule GSS, which is included in Transco’s Rate Schedules GSS and LSS fuel retention percentages. The filing included revised tariff records for Rate Schedules GSS and LSS, proposed to be effective April 1, 2025.

Texas to Louisiana Energy Pathway Project – CP22-495-000

On March 27, 2025 Transco received a letter order granting Transco’s February 28, 2025, request, as supplemented on March 19, 2025, to place into service facilities associated with the Texas to Louisiana Energy Pathway Project (Project) and commence service. This authorization to place Project facilities into service includes Compressor Station 33 in Fort Bend County, Texas and modifications to Compressor Station 40 in Hardin County, Texas, as early as April 1, 2025.

Southeast Energy Connector Project – CP22-501-000

On March 27, 2025, Transco received a letter order granting Transco’s March 4, 2025, request to place into service facilities associated with the Southeast Energy Connector Project (Project) and commence service. This authorization to place Project facilities into

service includes approximately 1.90 miles of 42-inch pipeline loop in Chilton County and Coosa County, Alabama, pig trap removals on Mainline E in Chilton County and Coosa County, Alabama and modifications to Compressor Station 105 in Coosa County, Alabama, as early as April 1, 2025.
