2022 ACA Tracker Filing (Docket No. RP22-1147-000)

On August 25, 2022, Transco submitted revised tariff records to track rate changes resulting from an increase in the Annual Charge Adjustment rate from \$0.0012 to \$0.0015.

Southeast Energy Connector Project 7c Filing (Docket No. CP22-501-000)

On August 22, 2022, Transco filed an application pursuant to section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations for its proposed Southeast Energy Connector Project, an expansion of Transco's system to provide incremental firm transportation capacity to meet growing demand for natural gas in Alabama. The fully subscribed Project is proposed to provide additional, needed firm transportation capacity of 150,000 Dth/day from Transco's existing Petal Gas Receipt Meter Station on the Transco Mainline located at or near milepost 747 in Jasper County, Mississippi, and Transco's existing Station 85, Zone 4 Pool on the Transco Mainline located at milepost 784.66 in Choctaw County, Alabama, to Transco's existing Gaston Meter Station on the Transco Mainline located at milepost 926.82 in Coosa County, Alabama. The Project proposes to: (1) construct approximately 1.90 miles of 42-inch-diameter pipeline loop on its existing Mainline E in Chilton and Coosa Counties, Alabama; (2) remove existing pig traps at Mileposts 909.63 and 911.53 on its Mainline E; and (3) install an additional 11,110 ISO-rated horsepower gas-fired, turbine-driven compressor unit and modify three existing compressor units at its Compressor Station 105 in Coosa County, Alabama. The Project is targeted to be placed into service by September 1, 2025.

The deadline for filing a motion to intervene is 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on September 20, 2022.

Texas to Louisiana Energy Pathway Project 7c Filing (Docket No. CP22-495-000)

On August 9, 2022, Transco filed an application under section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations to construct, install, modify, operate and maintain its Texas to Louisiana Energy Pathway Project (Project) and to authorize the conversion of 130,000 dekatherms per day (Dth/day) of capacity currently subject to Transco's "IT Feeder System" to firm transportation capacity under the Project. Specifically, Transco requests authorization to i) construct a new 15,900 horsepower compressor station in Fort Bend County, Texas, ii) modify six existing compressor units at Compressor Station 40 in Hardin County, Texas, iii) as well as perform programming updates at Compressor Station 23 in Victoria County, Texas to accommodate new flow conditions. The capacity conversion, along with turnback capacity and incremental capacity, will yield the 364.4 million cubic feet per day of project capacity. The Project is targeted to be placed into service in the first quarter of 2025.

The deadline for filing a motion to intervene is 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on September 13, 2022.

Commonwealth Energy Connector Project 7c Filing (Docket No. CP22-502-000)

On August 24, 2022, Transco filed an application pursuant to section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations for its proposed Commonwealth Energy Connector Project, an expansion of Transco's system to provide an additional 105,000 Dth/day of firm transportation service from Transco's existing Station 165 Zone 5 Pooling Point in Pittsylvania County, Virginia, through Transco's South Virginia Lateral, to the existing Emporia interconnection. The Project will involve the construction and operation of an additional 33,000 horsepower Electric Motor-Driven compressor and related modifications at Compressor Station 168 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia, approximately 6.35 miles of 24-inch diameter pipeline extension of Transco's South Virginia Lateral B-Line (referred to as the Commonwealth Loop) in Brunswick and Greensville Counties, Virginia, including appurtenant facilities, and modifications at the existing Emporia M&R Station in Greensville County, Virginia. The Project is targeted to be placed into service by November 1, 2025.

Compressor Station 61 Abandonment Project Filing (Docket No. CP22-505-000)

On August 30, 2022, Transco filed an application pursuant to Section 7(b) of the Natural Gas Act, the prior notice procedures prescribed by Sections 157.205 and 157.216 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's Regulations, and Transco's blanket certificate issued in Docket No. CP82-426, requesting authorization to abandon its Compressor Station 61 and appurtenant facilities, all located in Jackson, East Feliciana Parish, Louisiana.
