Commonwealth Energy Connector - Order Issuing Certificate (Docket No. CP22-502-000)

On August 24, 2022, Transco filed an application requesting authorization to construct and operate the Commonwealth Energy Connector Project (CEC project). The proposed CEC project consists of the installation of a new 33,000 horsepower (hp) electric motor-driven compressor and related modifications at Compressor Station 168 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia; Approximately 6.35 miles of 24-inch diameter pipeline and appurtenant facilities for the extension of Transco's South Virginia Lateral B-Line in Brunswick and Greensville Counties, Virginia; modifications and installation of new facilities at the existing Emporia M&R Station in Greensville County, Virginia. The purpose of the CEC project is to provide up to an additional 105,000 dekatherms per day (Dth/d) of firm transportation service for its shipper. On November 16, 2023, FERC issued the requested certificate of public convenience ("certificate") and necessity subject to conditions. On November 28, 2023, Transco filed a letter accepting the certificate.

Rate Schedule S-2 OFO Refund Report (Docket No. RP24-143-000)

On November 3rd, Transco submitted its Flow Through of Texas Eastern's OFO Penalty Disbursement Report (Docket No. RP23-175-000). On October 10, 2023, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC ("Transco") received its portion of the penalty disbursement for storage service purchased under Texas Eastern's Rate Schedule X-28 which is used by Transco to provide service to its customers under its Rate Schedule S-2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 26.2(b) of Transco's General Terms and Conditions, Transco refunded the amount received from Texas Eastern, with interest, to its Rate Schedule S-2 customers on November 3, 2023.

Southeast Energy Connector Project - Order Issuing Certificate (Docket No. CP22-501-000)

On August 22, 2022, Transco filed an application pursuant to section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations for its proposed Southeast Energy Connector Project, an expansion of Transco's system to provide incremental firm transportation capacity to meet growing demand for natural gas in Alabama. On November 16, 2023, FERC issued the requested certificate of public convenience ("certificate") and necessity subject to conditions. On November 29, 2023, Transco filed a letter accepting the certificate.

Alabama Georgia Connector Environmental Assessment (Docket No. CP23-194-000)

On November 27, 2023, the staff of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued its environmental assessment for the Alabama Georgia Connector Project. FERC staff concludes that approval of the proposed Project, with appropriate mitigating measures, would not constitute a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment.
