Filing to Revise Section 49 of the General Terms and Conditions (Docket No. RP24-728-000)

On May 1, 2024, Transco filed proposed revisions to Section 49 of the General Terms and Conditions of its tariff to establish additional procedures for the solicitation of bids, through open season offerings, for firm service capacity identified on Transco's Unsubscribed Capacity Report as becoming available more than 90 days and up to three years in the future. On May 28, 2024, the FERC issued an order accepting the tariff revisions.

<u>Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Co. – Notice to Proceed with Construction (Docket No. CP22-502-001)</u>

On May 1, 2024, the FERC issued a full notice to proceed with construction for the Commonwealth Energy Connector Project in Mecklenburg, Brunswick, and Greensville Counties, Virginia

<u>Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Co. – Notice of Application and Establishing Intervention</u> <u>Deadline and Environmental Assessment (Docket No. CP24-469-000)</u>

On May 21, 2024, the FERC issued the Notice of Application ("NOA") and its Environmental Assessment ("EA") for Transco's Abandonment of Offshore Lateral from Mustang Island to Brazos Areas Project ("Project"). The purpose of the Project is to abandon in place Transco's offshore lateral extending from the Mustang Island Areas Block A-85 Platform to the Brazos Area Block A-133 Platform located in federal waters, offshore Texas. In the NOA and EA, FERC established a June 11, 2024, deadline for filing a motion to intervene and that its environmental review of the Project confirmed the action qualifies as a categorical exclusion and no EA is required. Transco has requested an order authorizing the Project as soon as possible or by no later than July 29, 2024.
