Northeast Supply Link Project (Docket No. CP12-30)

On December 4, 2012 Transco submitted supplemental information to the Commission explaining that WPX Energy Marketing, LLC, formerly known as Williams Gas Marketing, Inc., a shipper under the project, is no longer affiliated with Transco. Various parties submitted rehearing requests in this proceeding. On December 28, 2012, FERC issued a tolling order with respect to such rehearing requests. The Commission will address the merits of the rehearing requests in a future order.

Virginia Southside Expansion Project (Docket No. CP13-30-000)

On December 19, 2012, Transco filed an application under section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act for a certificate authorizing Transco to construct and operate the Virginia Southside Expansion Project (“Project”). The Project is an expansion of Transco’s existing pipeline system that will provide 270,000 dekatherms per day of incremental firm transportation service in its southern market area. The Project facilities include the construction and operation of approximately 91 miles of new pipeline facilities along Transco’s existing South Virginia Lateral “A”, approximately 7 miles of greenfield pipeline facilities, and a new compressor station with two 10,915 horsepower (ISO) gas turbine-driven compressors.

Brandywine Creek Mainline “A” Replacement Project (Docket No. CP12-497)

On December 28, 2012, FERC issued a Notice of Revised Schedule for Environmental Review, with a projected issuance date for the Environmental Assessment of January 25, 2013.
