Transco's General Section 4 Rate Case Filing (Docket No. RP12-993-002)

Transco has been served with, and has responded to, numerous discovery requests by several participants, including the Commission's Staff. The discovery process is continuing. On February 15, 2013, the Commission Staff served its top sheets, and the initial settlement conference occurred on February 21, 2013 in Washington, DC. The next settlement conference has been scheduled for April 17, 2013 in order to give all parties the opportunity to review end of test period actual data prior to circulating any new offers. On February 28, 2013 Transco made its motion filing to place revised rates into effect on March 1, 2013, subject to refund.

Revised Fuel Retention Percentages Proposed Effective April 1, 2013 (Docket No. RP13-632-000)

On February 28, 2013, Transco made its annual fuel tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2013. The revised fuel retention percentages can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

Revised Electric Power Rates Proposed Effective April 1, 2013 (Docket No. RP13-618-000)

On March 1, 2013, Transco made its annual electric power tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2013. The revised rates can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

Eminence Storage Partial Abandonment Project (Docket No. CP11-551)

On February 7, 2013, the Commission issued in Docket Nos. CP11-551-000 and RP12-993-001 an "Order Approving Abandonment, Amending Certificate Authority, and Granting Clarification" authorizing Transco to abandon four of seven existing gas storage caverns at the Eminence storage field and authorizing corresponding reductions of the storage capacity quantities and storage demand quantities in Eminence customers' service agreements under Rate Schedules ESS and EESWS. The reductions in storage capacity and storage demand quantities were implemented effective February 28, 2013.
