### **Update on Transco's General Section 4 Rate Case Filing (Docket No. RP12-993)**

On February 28, 2013, Transco submitted its motion rate filing to be effective March 1, 2013, subject to refund. The motion rate filing reflects the rates suspended by the Commission's order of September 28, 2012 adjusted (i) to reflect the costs associated with facilities in service as of February 28, 2013, the end of the Docket No. RP12-993 test period and (ii) to incorporate, as appropriate, intervening filings which were made effective subsequent to the August 31, 2012 rate case filing.

The initial settlement conference occurred on February 15, 2013 and primarily focused on a review of FERC Staff's top sheet position. On March 25, 2013, Transco provided to the parties actual cost data through the end of the test period. The next settlement conference is scheduled for April 17-18, 2013.

### **Revised Fuel Retention Percentages Effective April 1, 2013 (Docket No. RP13-632-000)**

On March 1, 2013, Transco made its annual fuel tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2013. On March 25, 2013, the Commission issued a letter order accepting Transco's filing, as proposed. The revised fuel retention percentages can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.

### **Revised Electric Power Rates Effective April 1, 2013 (Docket No. RP13-618-000)**

On March 1, 2013, Transco made its annual electric power tracker filing proposed effective April 1, 2013. On March 21, 2013, the Commission issued a letter order accepting Transco's filing, as proposed. The revised rates can be found in the rates matrices contained in 1Line's Informational Postings – Regulatory section.
