Northeast Connector Project (Docket No. CP13-132)

On April 9, 2013, Transco submitted an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for its Northeast Connector Project, an expansion of Transco's existing pipeline system which will enable Transco to provide an additional 100,000 dekatherms per day (dt/day) of transportation service to National Grid NY from Transco's existing Compressor Station 195 to an interconnection between Transco's existing Lower New York Bay Lateral at or near milepost 34.31 in New York State waters and the proposed Rockaway Delivery Lateral. FERC has consolidated the environmental review of this project with the Rockaway Delivery Lateral Project (CP13-32).

Abandonment of South Marsh Island 49 Laterals (Docket No. CP13-131)

On April 9, 2013, Transco submitted a request for authority, pursuant section 7(b) of the Natural Gas Act and Commission regulations, to abandon, in place, certain pipeline facilities located in offshore Louisiana adjacent to South Marsh Island Block 49 of Transco's Southeast Louisiana Lateral. Specifically, Transco proposes to abandon approximately 57 miles of supply laterals known as the SMI 49 Laterals.

Rate Schedule SS-2 Annual Inventory Adjustment Compliance Filing (Docket No. RP13-814-000)

On April 24, 2013, Transco submitted a filing with the Commission to track a third-party adjustment affecting Rate Schedule SS-2 customers' storage inventory balances. This filing was made in compliance with Section 8(c) of Transco's Rate Schedule SS-2, which provides that Transco will track annually to its Rate Schedule SS-2 customers the adjustment made by National Fuel to Transco's storage inventory under National Fuel's Rate Schedule SS-1 related to transportation purchased by Transco under National Fuel's Rate Schedule X-54. Upon acceptance, Transco's adjustment to its Rate Schedule SS-2 customers' storage inventory will be made effective May 1, 2013.

Filing of Annual Blanket Certificate Report and Section 2.55(b) Report

Transco submitted the annual reports required to be filed with the Commission by May 1 of each year in accordance with Sections 2.55(b) and 157.207 of the Regulations. Pursuant to Section 2.55(b), Transco submitted a report for 57 replacement projects completed in 2012, and pursuant to Section 157.207, Transco submitted a report for 11 construction projects and 27 abandonment projects completed during 2012 under Transco's blanket certificate authorization.
