**Horsepower Replacement at Compressor Station 205 (Docket No. CP12-463)**

On July 30, 2012, FERC issued an Environmental Assessment finding no adverse effects resulting from Transco's proposed replacement of two existing electric motors with two new electric motors at Transco's existing Station 205 in Princeton, New Jersey. Specifically, Transco proposes to replace two 7,000 horsepower high speed electric motors and associated variable frequency drives for Units 1 and 2 with two new Siemens electric motors with new variable frequency drives that will be certificated and operated at 7,000 horsepower each. The Prior Notice request to replace the two electric motors, which was noticed by the Commission on May 29, 2012, is deemed approved as of July 30, 2012.

**Submittal of Negotiated Rates - Mid-South Expansion Project, Phase 1**

On August 1, 2012, Transco filed tariff records that summarize the essential elements of two executed service agreements that contain negotiated rates under Rate Schedule FT between Transco and Carolina Power & Light Company d/b/a Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc. and Transco and they City of LaGrange, Georgia. The negotiated rates will be effective on the in-service date of Phase 1 of Transco's Mid-South Expansion Project, currently anticipated to be September 1, 2012.
