### **Brandywine Creek Mainline “A” Replacement (Docket No. CP12-497)**

On July 18, 2013, FERC issued an “Order Issuing Certificate and Approving Abandonment” authorizing Transco to replace approximately 2,167 feet of existing 30-inch pipeline on Transco’s mainline in East Brandywine and East Caln Townships, Chester County, Pennsylvania with a 42-inch pipeline. On July 24, 2013, Transco accepted the Certificate. Transco intends to perform the necessary pipeline replacement activities in 2014.

### **Mobile Bay South III (Docket No. CP13-523)**

On July 18, 2013, Transco filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing Transco to construct and operate its Mobile Bay South III Expansion Project, an expansion of the southbound transportation capacity on Transco’s Mobile Bay Lateral. The project will allow Transco to provide 225,000 dt/day of firm, year-round transportation service from Transco’s Station 85 Zone 4A pool in Choctaw County, Alabama to existing interconnections on the Mobile Bay Lateral with Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC near Citronelle and Bay Gas Storage Company, Ltd. in Mobile County, Alabama.
