Transco General Rate Case Filing (RP12-993-000)

On August 31, 2012 Transco filed a Section 4 general rate case proposed to be effective October 1, 2012. After suspension, the increased rates are expected to become effective March 1, 2013, subject to refund. The principal factors supporting the increased cost of service are (a) an increase in operation and maintenance expenses, (b) an increase in depreciation expense, and (c) an increase in the cost of asset retirement obligations. Order Accepting Tariff Filing to Revise Pooling Charges at Transco's Market Area Pools in Zones 5 and 6 (Docket No. RP12-925-000)

On August 23, 2012, the Commission issued a letter order accepting tariff records filed by Transco on August 3, 2012, to revise how zonal usage charges and fuel retention are assessed to quantities pooled at its market area pools in Zones 5 and 6 (i.e., the Station 165 Zone 5 Pool and the Station 210 Zone 6 Pool). Zonal usage charges and fuel retention for the zone in which the pool is located will apply to quantities pooled at these locations only once, upon transportation into the pool. The effective date of the revised tariff records is October 1, 2012.

Mid-South Expansion Project (Docket No. CP11-18)

Phase I of the Mid-South Expansion Project will be placed in service on September 12 as authorized by the Commission.

On August 16, 2012, the Commission issued a Letter Order in Docket No. RP12-916-000 approving tariff records reflecting two negotiated rate agreements under Rate Schedule FT between Transco and Carolina Power & Light Company, LLC d/b/a Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc. and Transco and the City of LaGrange, Georgia. The tariff records are effective on September 12, 2012, the in-service date of Phase I of Transco's Mid-South Expansion Project.

On August 17, 2012, the Commission issued a Letter Order in Docket No. RP12-910 accepting Transco's August 1, 2012 filing of tariff records to implement the approved recourse rates for the Mid-South Expansion Project effective on the in-service date, September 12, 2012.

Brandywine Creek Mainline "A" Replacement (Docket No. CP12-497)

On August 8, Transco filed a 7(c) application for authorization to replace approximately 2,167 feet of existing 30-inch pipeline on Transco's mainline in East Brandywine and East Caln Townships, Chester County, Pennsylvania with a 42-inch pipeline. FERC

issued the Notice on August 20, 2012. The comment period closes September 10, 2012.
