**Northeast Supply Link Project (Docket No. CP12-30)**

On November 2, 2012, FERC issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the Northeast Supply Link Project. The Northeast Supply Link Project is an expansion of Transco's existing pipeline system that will provide 250,000 dekatherms per day of incremental firm transportation service in Zone 6 from certain supply interconnections on Transco's Leidy Line in Pennsylvania to Transco's 210 Market Pool in New Jersey and the existing Manhattan, Central Manhattan, and Narrows delivery points in New York City.

**Order Accepting Version 2.0 of the NAESB Standards (Docket No. RP12-1076-000)**

On November 8, 2012, the Commission issued a letter order approving Transco's September 27, 2012 filing to comply with Order No. 587-V which adopted Version 2.0 of the NAESB Standards effective December 1, 2012.

**Penalty Revenue Sharing Report (Docket No. RP12-91-000)**

On November 9, 2012, Transco filed a report of penalty amounts collected during the 12 month period ending July 31, 2012, pursuant to Section 54 of Transco's General Terms and Conditions. Section 54 states that if the cumulative penalty revenue collected at the end of the twelve month period ending each July 31 ("Annual Period") does not exceed \$100,000, Transco shall retain the penalty revenue for distribution to eligible buyers until the Annual Period during which the cumulative undistributed penalty revenue collected exceeds \$100,000. For the annual period ended July 31, 2012, the cumulative undistributed penalty revenue collected was \$9,071.
